

Pastor's Corner



Being back in the Benicia Farmer's Market this year has been such a joy. One thing I have especially enjoyed has been the fact that I have been starting out there earlier in the day. Last year, Brother Anselm and I shared the job. He did the first half, and then after praying

vespers, I would walk out to 1st Street for the second shift, freeing him to walk home and join the other brothers for dinner. Then at the end of the evening, I would pack up our tent, table, and other stuff with the help of our volunteers, load up the car wherever Brother Anselm had managed to find a parking spot earlier that day, and head home. Now I do both shifts since Thursday is Father Gregory's day off, and we do not have a residency brother. I am actually liking being out there for the full stretch, because there are so many young families to meet during the earlier part of the day. The weather is also more pleasant earlier in the day, as 1st Street can get a bit cold and windy after 6pm. Although that was certainly not the case this past Thursday! It was pretty dang hot out there, but wonderful, nevertheless. Ministering in the farmer's market still requires patience. Offering the free rosaries, we still hear, "no, thank you," a lot, and yet quite a few people do stop to receive a rosary and to chat. It is very common to encounter people who say they have been away from mass for various reasons and would like to return. I have also tweaked my approach. For example, instead of blessing all of



the rosaries at the beginning of that day's market, I wait and offer to bless each rosary when I give it to whomever is receiving it. The people always seem eager to have me do that, and then I

expand it into a blessing for the person as well, which they seem to appreciate. Something else fun out there has been noticing how many more people in Benicia I know, now, compared to last summer – including non-parishioners. As some of the Benicia police officers patrolled by us, I chuckled to myself, thinking, "I even know them better, now!" Right after thinking that, a woman I know who works for one of the local public schools stopped by to give me a hug and invite me to join her husband (whom I've also come to know) and their friends out in front of one of the nearby pubs. Before I knew it, I was seated outdoors, clinking glasses with new acquaintances, and enjoying a refreshing pint as the merry crowds mingled among the vendors. We sure are blessed to live here. Let's all keep working together to remind our neighbors who exactly it is who has bestowed that blessing upon us!


