Pastor's Corner



This sure has been an intense week for me. I imagine that by now many of you have heard about my very unexpected and bizarre encounter with the Benicia Police on the evening of Friday, May 17th. I am glad to be able to report that we are well on our way to clearing up this very strange misunderstanding that appears to have had its roots in an error

made by the Los Angles County Sheriff's Department. This apparent error mistakenly connected my driver's license number to an arrest warrant for a different "Andrew Opsahl" in southern California. Published in this bulletin is a copy of the most recent statement from the Western Dominican Province about the matter, as well as a very kind and helpful letter from Mark Menesini, Interim Chief of the Benicia Police Department. If you encounter people with questions about the incident, please refer them to these statements. Thanks to documentation retrieved by the Chief Menesini, my attorney is confident he will have an easy time demonstrating my innocence and getting the incident expunged. In the midst of dealing with that issue, it was nevertheless so joyful for me to carry Our Lord through the Benicia streets as part of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage last Tuesday.

Thanks to the help of so many of you parishioners. we all really knocked that one out of the park! We greeted the bishop's boat with a large crowd, including some of our St. Dominic's School kids and many parishioners. Thanks to the help of our safety volunteers and some skilled serving from our Dominican student brothers, the procession went very smoothly. One of my favorite parts of the procession was walking with the Eucharist up to the front doors of our church as our second-graders, dressed in their First Holy Communion clothes, threw rose petals in Our Lord's path. The church was packed, and the overall atmosphere was joyful and reverent. After we processed back to the boat's dock in the marina, it was very special to be able to offer the crowd a Eucharistic blessing with Jesus in the monstrance. As the boat pulled away with the Blessed Sacrament, the bishop and his entourage, and some of our parish teens, the crowd cheered, waving goodbye. It was so cool! God is truly blessing our parish! Thank you all for the support, trust, and love you have extended to me throughout this week. And thank you for helping to make our participation in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage such a success!

Based on documentation retrieved by the Benicia Police Department from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, we believe we have some clarity on the likely cause of the mistaken identity that led to Father Andrew Opsahl, OP, being arrested by local police last Friday, May 17th. An error was made on the part of Los Angeles County authorities that linked Father Andrew's driver's license to a different person named "Andrew Opsahl" in southern California – a different "Andrew Opsahl" for whom Los Angeles County had an outstanding arrest warrant. The Western Dominican Province is working with a Los Angeles-based attorney to resolve this case of mistaken identity so that Father Andrew's name can be justly cleared. We thank the Benicia Police Department for following up on its presumption of Fr. Andrew's innocence.



Father Opsahl,

I wanted to follow up with a letter after our meeting on Monday, regarding the police incident on Friday, May 17th. As the Interim Chief of Police, I hold my personnel to the highest standards. Therefore, I am frustrated by the errors made by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department in not taking great care to ensure that the information they input into the arrest warrant was correct. The misinformation entered into that document has undoubtedly caused you, St. Dominic's Church, and the Benicia Police Department a great deal of turmoil.

I am hopeful that the Western Dominican Province is able to resolve this case of mistaken identity quickly. Your willingness to allow me the opportunity to bring clarity to this situation was much appreciated. It was important for me to investigate the incident further, and I am glad that I was able to provide the evidence needed to resolve any questions regarding your innocence. It is my hope that the citizens of Benicia and the members of your congregation will surround you with support and understanding.

If I can be of any assistance as you navigate the process of purging your name or association with this warrant from the record, please do not hesitate to reach out.
