Pastor's Corner



This past week, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back in some form to the 11th Century, but it has taken the form we know today, largely due to apparitions of Our Lord experienced by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun, in 1675. During

those apparitions. Jesus told Saint Margaret Mary that he wanted the Church to establish a feast day dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday after the Feast of Corpus Christi. A key reason was in response to ingratitude among the faithful for what Jesus had done for them through his Passion and death. We are certainly all capable of falling into such ingratitude. And when we slide into that ingratitude, we can be sure that at least part of the problem is that we have allowed our various loves to become disordered. We end up loving ephemeral, worldly things too much, and our Savior not enough. I remember on the first day of one of my theology classes at the Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology, the professor said, "Always have a clear sense of what you love. What you love the most will reveal what you are mostly about as a person." The goal for us, as Christians, is for everything we do to be rightly oriented toward love of God. When what we love is at odds with love of God, corrosion in our souls is sure to follow. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus can help us reform the way we love. The heart, after all, is often a symbol of a person's interior and his or her capacity to love. As members of Christ's Body, we are able to share in Christ's heart, his capacity to love, enabling us to love with his supernatural love. When we allow the Holy Spirit to reform our hearts and make them like Christ's heart, it is then that we can love our enemies the way Christ loved his. And most importantly, it is through our share in Christ's capacity to love that we are able to properly love the Father, which gives us a part in the divine life of the Trinity. We have a beautiful statue dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the left side of our church's sanctuary. Every time we see that statue, let's all make it an occasion to ask Christ to help us love more like him, to have hearts that our like the Sacred Heart of Jesus!
