## Pastor's Corner



Well, this Sunday we begin our first full week of Lent. It is the time of year when we focus in a special way on Our Lord's Passion and death, by which he atoned for our sins and won our Salvation. In light of this, it is a time for cultivating greater clarity about where sin is infecting our souls. One of the

things on our minds, no doubt, is what we have chosen to do for Lenten penances. Are you already climbing the walls without your sweets, alcohol, social media, or whatever you have chosen to cut back on for these next six weeks? When choosing comforts to forgo during Lent, it's important to remember that part of the goal of our Lenten practices is to make it to the end of Lent in a better state, spiritually, than we were at the start of the season. A helpful step in making this a reality is to ask ourselves if there are any areas of excessive consumption in our lives. For example, do we binge-watch Netflix too much? Is "retail therapy" a crutch we use? Do we zone out habitually in front of social media, YouTube, or scroll endlessly in front of trivial headlines? In regard to other aspects of our moral lives, how often do we find ourselves engaging in toxic speech, like gossip or lashing out at those around us, due to stress coming from other aspects of our lives? Is there a holier and more effective way we could be dealing with the root causes of that stress? Lent is a great time of the year for taking stock of the different areas of our lives where we may be falling short. I recommend writing them out as a list or a chart, because seeing that stuff staring back at us on paper can help it sink in more as a reality. This can make it easier for us to be motivated to think of strategies for improvement and to act on those strategies. Maybe your plan is, rather than completely eliminating one thing from your life for Lent, you find several, like YouTube, social media, and impulse-Amazon purchases to reduce significantly during the season. As for gossip, we could take up the practice of praying five Hail Marys for any person about whom we might gossip, each time we catch ourselves gossiping. In general, I find it helpful to create a multifaceted plan for Lenten observance. If you try this for the next six weeks, you just may get to Easter Sunday and find at that point that you have acquired several healthy new habits for your spiritual life that you would like to continue on with into Easter and beyond!

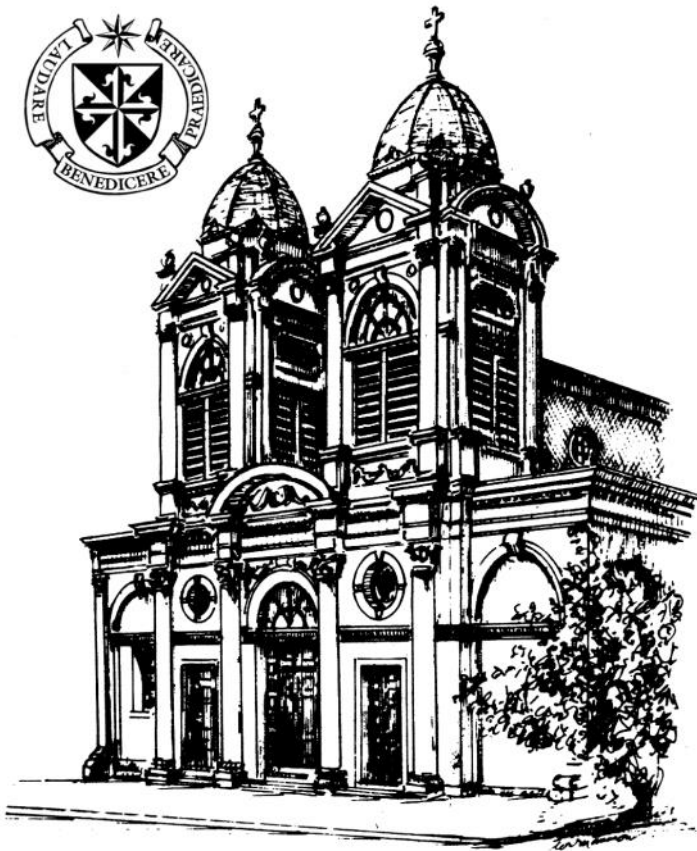

## Adult Confirmation Spring 2024

Each year, Bishop Soto extends an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation to practicing adult Catholics of the Diocese of Sacramento who are baptized, have received First Communion, and have received religious instruction since their First Communion, but for various reasons were never received the Sacrament of Confirmation.



The next celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation is scheduled for Saturday, May 18, 2024, at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament, Sacramento, 5:00 p.m. Candidates will be prepared at the parish level by completing 8 sessions held over a series of consecutive Sundays from March 10, 2024 through May 5, 2024, 3:00-4:30 p.m., St. Dominic's Ministry Center, Siena Rm.

Sacrament preparation will include prayer, scripture and a review of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. To participate the candidate must be a baptized Catholic, who has received catechetical instruction at least up to receiving the Eucharist (First Communion), be either unmarried or in a marriage recognized as valid by the Catholic Church, and have a recent copy of their Baptismal Certificate certified within the past 6 months. Confirmation candidates must select a Sponsor who must be Catholic, received the Sacrament of Confirmation, is a practicing Catholic, and is at least 16 years of age.

Organ Prelude: Reflective Interlude in B by Colin Mawby

**Colin Mawby** (9 May 1936 – 24 November 2019) was an English organist, choral conductor and composer. From 1961 he was Master of Music at Westminster Cathedral, then from 1981 he was the choral director at Radio Telefís Éireann. He composed masses dedicated to specific choirs, including in Germany. He was awarded Knighthood of the Order of St. Gregory in 2006.

Organ Postlude: Prelude in G minor from 8 Short Preludes and Fugues by J. S. Bach

The **Eight Short Preludes and Fugues** (also **Eight Little Preludes and Fugues**), BWV 553–560, are a collection of works for keyboard and pedal formerly attributed to Johann Sebastian Bach. They are now believed to have been composed by one of Bach's pupils, possibly Johann Tobias Krebs or his son Johann Ludwig Krebs, or by the Bohemian composer Johann Caspar Ferdinand Fischer.

Choral meditation: Lord of Life King of Glory by Michelangelo Grancini

**Michel'Angelo Grancini** (Grancino, born in Milan, 1605; died in Milan, April 17, 1669) was an Italian organist and composer. Grancini composed sacred music. Nineteen volumes were published in Milan (1622–29). Some 200 works are at the Milan Cathedral.

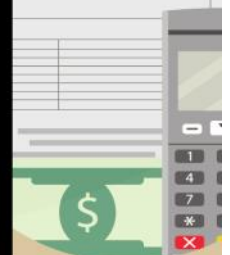
