

Pastor's Corner



This past week, the day finally arrived for several of our parish teens to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. The candidates for this sacrament have undergone two years of preparation, and they seemed very happy at their rehearsal to finally be reaching this milestone. I reminded them last Sunday that

through the Sacrament of Confirmation, the grace of their baptism would be brought to perfection. The sacrament is meant to help them rise to spiritual adulthood. In light of this, I have been encouraging them to see the grace of the sacrament as a means of taking more personal ownership of their faith. I imagine for many of them, taking that ownership will be an unfolding process as they navigate the rest of high school, college, and beyond that. I tell them that I first sensed my vocation to the priesthood a few years after my Confirmation. When I got that intuition of God's call, I was a sophomore in high school at a Sunday evening Life Teen mass. The Prayers of the Faithful were being read, and when the woman reading them said, "For an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life, we pray to the Lord." As everyone else in the congregation responded, "Lord, hear our prayer," I said to myself, "Huh, something tells me I am going to be one of the men called to the priesthood." And then after a second or so, I thought, "Really, me?!" I certainly valued my faith enough to have gotten Confirmed, but I did not want my whole life to be oriented toward that faith. At that time, going to Mass on Sundays was plenty of religion for me. As I grew into adulthood and gradually took more and more personal ownership of my faith, however, I realized my whole life needed to be oriented, in some way, toward knowing, serving, and loving God, regardless of my vocation. As I learned to make God the center of my life, rather than just something on the side, God revealed to me my vocation. I believe it works that way for all of us. We must make God the center of our lives, and from that mindset, we will be best disposed to recognize and take the steps he is inviting us to walk. As we grow in that clarity, no doubt the sacramental grace of our Confirmation is unfolding and pulling us closer home to the Father. As the kids in this year's Confirmation class walk forward in the coming days, months, and years, let's keep their journeys of faith in our prayers.

Organ music for 7:30 & 11 a.m. Masses Prelude: Adagio from organ concerto # 2 by J. S. Bach Bach composed his organ concertos during his Weimar period, when he was an organist at the court of the Duke of

Weimar. At that time, he became familiar and influenced by the music of Vivaldi. In fact, many believe that his organ concertos are arrangements of Vivaldi violin concertos.

Postlude: Postlude: Prince of Denmark's March by Jeremiah Clarke

The **Prince of Denmark's March**, commonly called the <u>Trumpet Voluntary</u>, was written around 1700 by the English composer Jeremiah Clarke, the first organist of the then newly-rebuilt St Paul's Cathedral. Popular as wedding music, the march was played during the wedding of Lady Diana Spencer and Prince Charles at St Paul's Cathedral in 1981.
