
















## **Pastor's Corner**



I love the vibe of freedom and confidence we get from the apostles in the mass readings during the Octave of Easter – especially in the readings from Acts of the Apostles. The close followers of Christ at this point seem to fear no earthly foe, given the mighty works they have seen done by the Lord. They have

witnessed the risen Christ. They have touched his wounds, and eaten with him on a seashore after another miraculously large catch of fish. His body is restored and is doing things the Gospels hadn't shown him doing before, like appearing in and vanishing from rooms. He has opened their minds to understand the scriptures and explained how the events of his life had carried out God's plan from of old, especially as revealed in those scriptures. The apostles have been given their mission to preach the joyful news of repentance and the promise of forgiveness of sins, and the fact that this bothers Jesus' adversaries does not deter the apostles one bit. The Jewish authorities try to scare the apostles out of telling the truth about the role those authorities played in Christ's death, but the apostles don't appear to bat an eyelash at these threats. The apostles make it clear to the authorities that if it's a matter of obeying God versus obeying them, only one of those two options makes any sense for the apostles. Consequently, they continue onward 'telling it like it is' and leaving Christianity's enemies throwing up their hands as to what to do about it. The apostles are working miracles as a sign of Christ's victory and the superior power those with faith in Jesus possess. Let us all strive to emulate the general mindset we see from the apostles during this time of the liturgical season. Around the beginning of Christ's earthly ministry in the temple in Jerusalem, he read from Isaiah and identified himself as the one who would herald a jubilee and proclaim liberty to captives. The fact of his Resurrection certainly drove home that message. The liberty he came to win for us was liberty from sin, which binds us more profoundly than anything else ever could bind a person. In Christ, we are bound no more. And we need not even fear death. Death has no power over him, for by death he defeated death, once and for always! Every time, through weakness, we slide into fear over anything in this life, let us all remember a key message of this season - that due to our share in Christ's Resurrection, regardless of any seemingly scary thing we face in this life, we need not fear because with Christ, we have already won!
