The weather this past week sure has been fantastic! I am happy to say that I have not yet gotten blasé about beautiful weather since my return to California last year. I feel a surge of gratitude every time I see our gorgeous blue sky. It has

been over a year since Father Carl brought me for a visit as the incoming pastor last April. I remember going jogging then to explore our neighborhood and thinking this place looked and felt like a paradise. We are so blessed to live in the Solano region of California. It is extra-easy for me to recognize this fact, given that before I arrived as pastor last July, I had spent four years in Alaska! Rarely has a day gone by when I have not thanked God for the privilege of being assigned at St. Dominic's in sunny Benicia. Cultivating regular gratitude for our blessings is important, because if we lack that habit, we can slide into seeing even a very blessed life as though it is nothing special. Prelude: Give me Jesus, spiritual arranged by Marques Garrett

The gospel hymn "Give Me Jesus" was written by Fanny Crosby. She is probably the most wellknown hymn-writer of all time. The song, emphasizing a personal relationship with Jesus, has been cherished by many and continues to be a source of inspiration for people around the world. Conductor, Educator and composer. composed by George Frideric Handel. It premiered on 17 July 1717, in response to King George I's request for a concert on the River Thames.

This hymn tune has an interesting history: written originally in 1660s by the German pastor Johann Rist, it was translated into English in 19th century by Catherne Winkworth, and then made its way into The Sacred Harp, an American collection of sacred songs.
