Pastor's Corner



This past week, we celebrated the memorial for Saint Maximilian Kolbe. One thing that especially struck me about Saint Maximilian was how productive he had managed to be for God before dying at age 47 at the hands of the Nazis in 1941. After becoming a Franciscan friar in Poland at age

16, following his seminary education, Saint Maximilian Kolbe managed to earn two doctorates, one in philosophy, the other in theology. He utilized his advanced learning to generate effective media outreach to foster greater holiness among the faithful. To do this, he established a prolific publishing house in Poland that promoted devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He established similar publishing houses in India and Japan. In addition to his publishing houses, he had radio broadcast equipment installed at his Polish monastery and started hosting a radio show from that location. This was, of course, many decades before another very famous Franciscan – Mother Angelica – would start her own TV show from her monastery. In the midst of all of Saint Maximilian's productivity, he stayed disciplined about keeping his prayer life at the core of his focus. Let us all strive to emulate Saint Maximilian's effectiveness for the Lord by staying focused on activity that truly enables us to thrive and is consistent with building the Kingdom of God. We should ask ourselves how much time we spend zoning out in front of social media or those frivolous newsfeeds that nab us with clickbait. In regard to clickbait, every time you feel tempted to read a story about some pop singer's personal life, say to yourself something like, "Wait...this singer does not read about my personal life. Why am I reading about her personal life?" Then, start thinking of the productive things you could be accomplishing for God, yourself, and for others. Saints like Maximilian Kolbe tend to be good at recognizing wastes of time that dull our souls, make us sadder, and less fruitful. It is one of the reasons they are often able to do such good for God and the world in very short periods of time. Something else Saint Maximilian Kolbe did to stay on the right track with God was that he cultivated a strong devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. This was wise because the Virgin Mary has such a great track record of helping Christians get closer to her Son. In general, we should strive to surround ourselves with people who encourage us to be the best versions of ourselves. It can only get us nearer to our full potential, which brings us closer to the perfect union with God for which he made us!

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.
