Pastor's Corner



For many of us, life this week will be about 'getting back into the swing of things.' Father Gregory will return from Taiwan, and soon our school kids will be back in the classroom. I imagine the kids right now are feeling a bit anxious as the summer clock runs out. They will see, however, that once they

get past the initial sting of stepping back on campus, the start of one's school year is actually a fun and hopeful time. They will have the chance to start things off right with their studies, and maybe get a needed reset socially in regard to how well they get along with their classmates and teachers. Football season will begin soon, and all of the fun holidays are on the horizon. My goal is to remind them to keep Our Lord in focus as they navigate the year and strive to grow into the best versions of themselves. We all should really share that goal as we move together toward the end of summer. Ever since I became a Dominican, August has been a month during which I have spent extra time reflecting on how I have done in my journey as a man since the previous August and how I hope to have grown in my walk with the Lord by the following August. Whether you choose this month or some other for such rumination, it is a valuable practice to repeat routinely because otherwise, our years can mount very quickly before we realize we have spent too much time just treading water with the status quo. Here are a few pieces of advice I plan on giving our school kids on the first day of school. One, let's try to avoid procrastinating on things we need to do. Falling into this habit is a recipe for anxiety that can become guite difficult to resolve if we let the bad habit go on too long. This needless anxiety is bad for our prayer lives. Two, stupid, avoidable interpersonal conflicts with friends and family tend to consume a lot of emotional bandwidth to the detriment of our relationship with God and happiness in general. We all need to avoid dumb drama just as much as our school kids do! Three, let's be really intent on keeping worship at the heart of our lives. That plays a key role in keeping us on the right path as we navigate the various challenges and joys of the coming year. Of course, saying all of this in the abstract is the easy part. Doing it is more difficult, but each of us is capable of making these goals realities is we present them to God and put in the work toward improvement with the help of his grace.


