Pastor's Corner



It was fun preaching on the Solemnity of All Saints for our school kids a few weeks ago. I pointed out to them that while many people think All Saints Day celebrates only famous canonized saints, like Saints Dominic, Catherine, Teresa, and Francis, the truth is it is meant to celebrate all of the saints in Heaven, whether canonized or not. I explained that the famous canonized saints should be seen sort of like favorite players on an NFL football team. Such athletes can inspire us to be the best we can be. In this spirit, many of us even like to dress like them by wearing jerseys decorated with their names and numbers. This, of course, provided a fun opportunity for me to show the kids my Niners jersey, which sported the name of tight-end George Kittle. I told the kids that at the time I got the jersey, Kittle was my favorite player because I appreciated the good character he modeled. I admired the zealous way Kittle always seemed to give all of himself to every play on the field, trying like heck to get even one more inch forward before being completely stopped by a tackle. I also dug the way he was so generous about complimenting other players during his press conferences, seeming to delight in the greater glory of the overall team. However, then I went on to say that while Kittle remained one of my favorite players, lately I had found myself drawing more inspiration from quarterback Brock Purdy. This was because while Brock Purdy was an outstanding quarterback, he did not seem to allow the accolades he received to overtake his humility. Mostly, what I admired about Purdy was the open way he expressed his Christian faith, directing compliments he received about his ability toward the greater glory of God. Purdy also made a point to pray with other believing players on the field, including faithful athletes from the opposing team. I told the kids that, as Christians, the canonized saints were meant to inspire us in similar ways to grow in our own holiness. For example, Saint Dominic had a tremendous impact on key life choices of mine. As a younger person, it was the prospect of preaching that first attracted me to the priesthood. As a kid, mass homilies typically bored me. However, on the rare occasions when a homily did hold my attention, I found the experience so enriching. It made me love the idea of spending a life trying to offer others preaching that at least I would have found interesting. You can imagine then why I would have admired Saint Dominic for starting a religious order dedicated to the charism of preaching! Let us continue to draw inspiration and intercessory prayer from the saints in Heaven on this journey led by Christ home the Father!
