## Pastor's Corner



In this day and age, we tend to think of Thanksgiving as a secular day, but the feast commemorated by this holiday was certainly more than a secular celebration for the pilgrims in 1621.

Those early years for the Puritan settlers on the American continent could be quite brutal. And they endured that difficulty for the sake of being able to create a society aiming to live out their Christian faith in a way that reflected their view of doing so with full authenticity. No doubt at the first 'Thanksgiving' celebration, the pilgrims had an intensely felt sense of reliance on God, as well as on each other for basic survival. Now centuries later, life is much easier in a material sense. However, that does not necessarily mean it will be easy to spend this Thanksgiving with a mentality of gratitude. While we may have warm homes, running water, cars, plenty to eat and so forth, the holidays can still feel like a chore, depending on our circumstances. Perhaps someone in our family is struggling with loss of employment or with health difficulties and not in the mood to playact pleasantness guests. Maybe we are blue because we have just retired from our career and are grieving the loss of something that formed an important part of our identity for many years. Perhaps we feel anxiety about the family members we will be obligated to spend time around for several hours on this day. If this is the case for any of us, what can help is to consciously treat Thanksgiving as the Christian day of gratitude for survival it was meant to be. We should approach the day with a mentality of thankfulness for our salvation. When we get up in the morning next Thursday, before our feet hit the floor, we should say to God, "Lord, help me to show you gratitude for my salvation by being the best version of myself today." When you arrive at the house where you will celebrate the holiday or when the company arrives at your dwelling, rather than preparing to 'put on a show,' prepare to offer God a gift by trying with the company not to be fake but rather to be the best, most sincere version of you that you can be in that situation. For example, if you find yourself in front of someone you find tiresome, rather than nursing resentment as you feign interest in this person's remarks or fake-laugh at his or her jokes, try saying a prayer for that person. Ask the Lord to help you appreciate your common humanity with him or her. And, again, ask God to help you to make that a gift to him. I am not guaranteeing this will make your Thanksgiving fun, but it can certainly make it soul-filling. And a fuller soul is a more grateful one. Regardless of our situations, we are so blessed to be alive and to know Jesus Christ. Happy Thanksgiving, everybody!

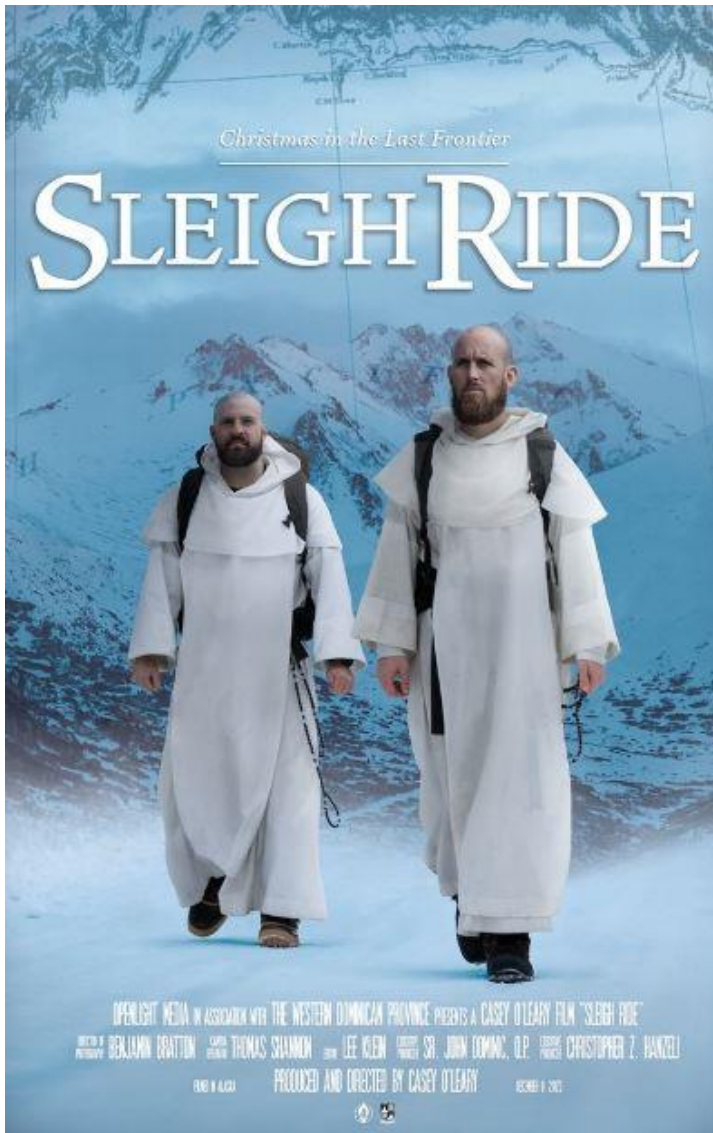
