Pastor's Corner



Our evening caroling at the Benicia Holiday Open House on 1st Street was a delight and definitely, something we plan to repeat next year! I had to show up late because for the first half-hour or so of caroling, I was busy leading prayer at Family Eucharistic Adoration, which was very prayerful and important, I believe, for the children. Not only did

they get help learning how to pray in front of the Eucharist, but also how to live the liturgical season. As we prayed in front of the Blessed Sacramento, I had the kids meditate on different ways they could prepare a way for the Lord to come on Christmas. I encouraged them to think of ways they were falling short at home, in school, and at church. Then I had them ruminate on ways they could improve in those three settings. I love that at Family Eucharistic Adoration, the kids are also learning how to pray Night Prayer and chant the Salve

Regina. At the end of Adoration, once we cleaned up the church, I raced down to 1st Street to join the carolers. As we sang, we passed out mass schedule flyers



and invited passersby to St. Dominic's for Christmas. What struck me as the most important benefit of our presence out there, however, was the mere fact that we were promoting the Christian purpose of the season amid the rowdy, secular festivities. As we caroled, large groups of people would stop and listen. Families put their arms around each other, and I noticed an expression that appeared almost to be one of relief on many faces, certainly grateful appreciation as we sang about Christ and his coming birth. It was a powerful reminder of what Jesus tells us in Matthew 9:37: "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his



harvest". So many people in our regional community, I believe, our thirsting for Christ, even if they do not yet realize it. It often just takes planting the seeds of invitations to yield a larger harvest. Let us hope our parish's Advent outreach efforts produce just that! The growth in mass attendance we have seen here at St.

Dominic's has happened in a slow but steady way. If we keep at it, that harvest will grow! Make sure to thank parishioner Jeannie Hamann for allowing us to sing in front of her business, Hamann Real Estate & Property Management!


