## **Pastor's Corner**



This past week, we had a daily mass reading from 1 John, Chapter Four in which John offers quite a reality check on what is required for truly loving God. "If anyone says, 'I love God,' but hates his brother, he is a liar; for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he

has not seen. This is the commandment we have from him: Whoever loves God must also love his brother." John here is basically saying that as a way of doing quality control on your love of God, reflect on how well you love your neighbor. How well we love our neighbors can tell us something about how well we actually love God. I find this truth sobering because while we may find our fellow Christians difficult to love, loving God can seem comparatively easy because we do not interact with him in the flesh the way we do with our neighbors. And if we are not careful, this easy love of God can be a form of projecting our preferences onto our idea of God in order to make him easier to love. When this happens, it is really ourselves we are loving more than God. We may call that projection of our preferences by the name of God, but what it really is is a kind of imaginary friend. That having been stated, let's face it, loving one's fellow Christians can feel rather difficult at times. One insight that has always helped me, however, is something I heard Father Michael Hurley say in a homily back when I was a vocation candidate for the Dominicans. He pointed out that people often confuse love between people for mutual affability. Loving someone requires willing the good of that person, regardless of whether or not the two of you hit it off socially. You do not need to like people to love them. This can make it easier to love our enemies. When it comes to such an enemy, try simply saying, "Lord, please help this person to repent of whatever this person needs to repent of in order to obtain your salvation, just like I want your salvation. I remember when I had become a novice and visited Saint Dominic's in Benicia to give my vocation story, I brought up that previous homily to Father Michael who was the pastor here at that point in time. He smiled and said, "Yeah, just think of Jesus when he was being crucified by the Roman soldiers. Jesus certainly loved those soldiers, but I don't think he felt like spending vacations with them." Let us all strive to love God by imitating the way he loved others, which wasn't driven by mutual affability, but rather by willing the good of his neighbors – both the fun ones and those less so!


