

Pastor's Corner



This past Thursday at the Farmer's Market, I got some fun reminders of what Jesus tells us in the Gospels about relying on him when it comes to our needs in regard to evangelizing. If we stay close to him, remain flexible, and accept the good opportunities that open for us, he will give us what we

need. My first opportunity to trust God in this way happened in my vehicle on the way to the market. As I drove down H Street toward 1st Street with my little Chevy Volt full of the components of our booth, it suddenly occurred to me I had forgotten to bring water, an oversight I have been guilty of before. I had no time to turn back to St. Dominic's, so I said, "Oh, well, I'll bet some water will show up for us out there." And later, while setting up our table, one of our parishioners stopped by to hand us some bottles of water! Although, before that need was met, when I first arrived to the market, I discovered the organizers had given the normal spot for our booth to another group and that the organizers were still trying to find a new location for us. This concerned me a little, because I had come to appreciate our normal spot near the entrance to the market. We had a lot of success there, I figured, because the pedestrians who passed us were either just arriving, feeling fresh and open to talking, or they were departing, had already gotten what they initially came to obtain (for many folks, the primary reason they visit the market is to buy one of those cups of rich, creamy corn sprinkled with crushed Flamin' Hot Cheeto dust.), and so with mission accomplished, were open to lastminute cool stuff the market had to offer, like our rosaries. The market organizers ended up placing our booth right in the midst of many of the food vendors. I accepted our spot politely but privately wondered if the visitors would be too distracted by the fresh-fried corn dogs, street tacos, caramel puffs, and icy drinks to talk to us. I mean, dang, those beloved Flamin' Hot Cheeto corn bowls were being sold just a booth away from us! As it turned out, however, we handed out numerous rosaries. I got to bless lots of people, and many lovely conversations happened. Some of the individuals said they indeed planned to see us at St. Dominic's on Sunday, so we shall see if that happens. Also, the food vendor to our immediate right turned out to be a practicing Catholic. He thanked us for being in the market and gave us some delicious free eggrolls! When it comes to our parish mission to evangelize, let's continue to stay close to God, be flexible, and accept the opportunities he sends our way!
