## **Pastor's Corner**



My trip to Helena, Montana last weekend was pretty cool! I did the wedding of a couple I knew from Alaska – Dutch Harbor, to be exact. It's the island in the Aleutian Island Chain where they filmed the Deadliest Catch.

Anyway, the groom last weekend was the brother of a groom whose wedding I did in Montana last summer, that time in a small church in a little town called Sulphur Springs. This year, the wedding was at the Cathedral of Saint Helena. The church was gorgeous, having been built in the early 1900s. The city, which is also the capitol of Montana, was rich with goldmining money at the time of the cathedral's construction, and boy is it a jewel. The stained-glass windows are stunning, the sanctuary well designed, and the soaringly high ceilings evoke thoughts of rising up to Heaven. The city of Helena had a striking appearance in general. It's complete with a hip-looking downtown, and yet surrounding the city is vast green fields, barns, horses, and low rising mountains. Strolling around the historic part of the downtown before I had to be at the wedding rehearsal, serendipitously, I bumped into a former parishioner of ours who now lives there with his family. It was such a fun coincidence! After he and I caught up on how life had been going for each of us, we said our goodbyes, and then I moved on to a very important part of my agenda for that day, which was to check out a few of the local bakeries. My favorite was a place downtown called "Dear Potato." It was a quirky little spot that I had a feeling would be great because of how they presented themselves on their website. After clicking on the tab for their menu, the site informed me that they had no menu and opted instead for a practice of making and selling whatever baked goods sounded delicious to them on any given day. If a bakery can manage to keep customers coming back while denying them a regular menu, I figured, it must be good. It was lunchtime, and I ordered a roll filled with thin slices of Beyond Beef (the place was totally vegetarian) and cabbage that had been sauteed with a savory mixture of seasonings. It was super tasty. I want to try to make something similar at home. The wedding went splendidly – very joyful and prayerful throughout. I ended my stay in Helena by concelebrating the Sunday 7:30am mass at the cathedral. The parishioners there were incredibly friendly! It was a good trip. How delightful it is to be back home in Benicia. I am sure looking forward to newly ordained Father John Peter Anderson coming to celebrate mass for us next Sunday at the 11am and 1pm masses. Also, make sure you say hello to Brother Raphael Akita Knox, a student brother who is staying with us for the summer to take a Latin class!
