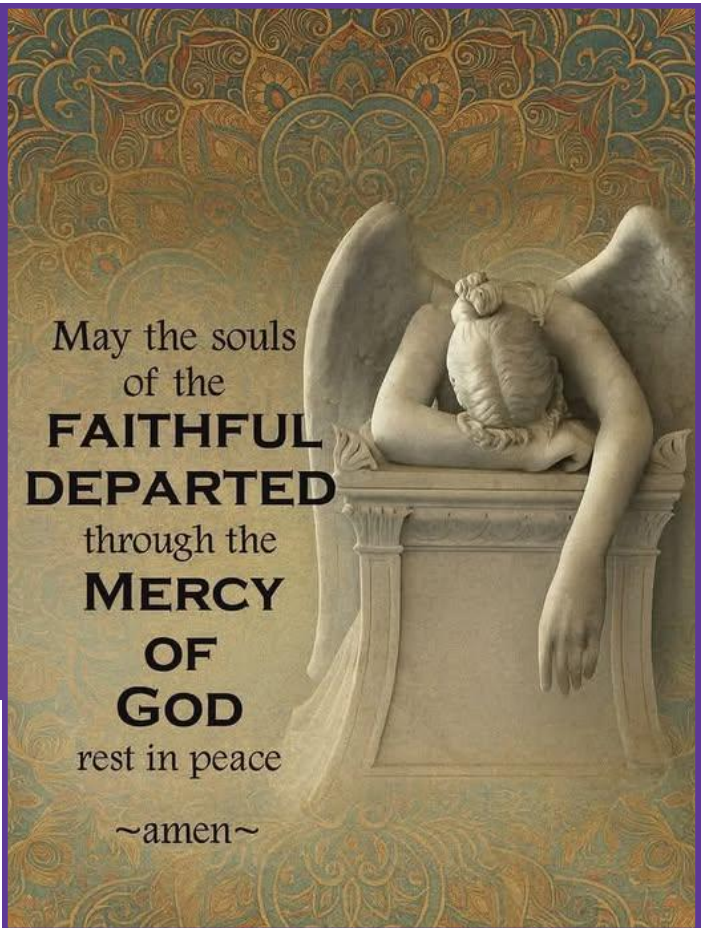

## Pastor's Corner



As our farmers market ministry closes for this year, it seems a good occasion for checking in on how we are doing with our parish-wide effort to evangelize and draw more people to Saint Dominic's. We appear to be succeeding, according to the mass attendance counts we recently did for the Diocese of Sacramento. For this year, our average weekend attendance was 1,138 people. By comparison, last year's weekend average was 939. This means in 2025 we have seen an increase of almost 200 people each weekend. To give further perspective, before Covid, in 2019, the average weekend attendance at St. Dominic's was 1,240 people. This year's counts indicate we are getting relatively close to pre-Covid numbers. In addition to the growth in weekend attendance, we are seeing more folks at weekday events in the parish, like our monthly family Eucharistic Adoration nights on first-Fridays. And at this past week's candlelight rosary procession, more than 80 people participated. Now in my third year here as pastor, one of my key insights has been there is no single, easy, 'quick-fix' means to building a parish to the extent that we aim to grow. Accomplishing that goal involves a slow-but-steady climb. Some newbies tell me they come because of the music, others because they like our religious education programs, others because the general vibe of our community resonates with them, and others are drawn to the preaching. Invitations are a key driver. Some of our new attendees have indeed come from the Farmers Market and other public-facing ministries of St. Dominic's, although my assumption is many have come from personal invitations you have all made to people you know. In terms of our efforts to get the parish's finances back in the black, my hope is these newcomers to Saint Dominic's will value what we offer here enough to start using the QR codes in the pews to support us. Whatever you can give each week makes such a difference. I really believe that if every family supported us with some amount each week, we could get ourselves into the black. Let's keep that goal in prayer! In other fun this past week, our eighth-graders did their annual pumpkin launch, an autumn classic here at St. Dominic's. The aim of the activity was for each team of students to use weight and tension calculations on their launch devices to successfully get their pumpkins to land in a kiddie pool 30 feet away. The young ladies pictured with me here succeeded at this goal!

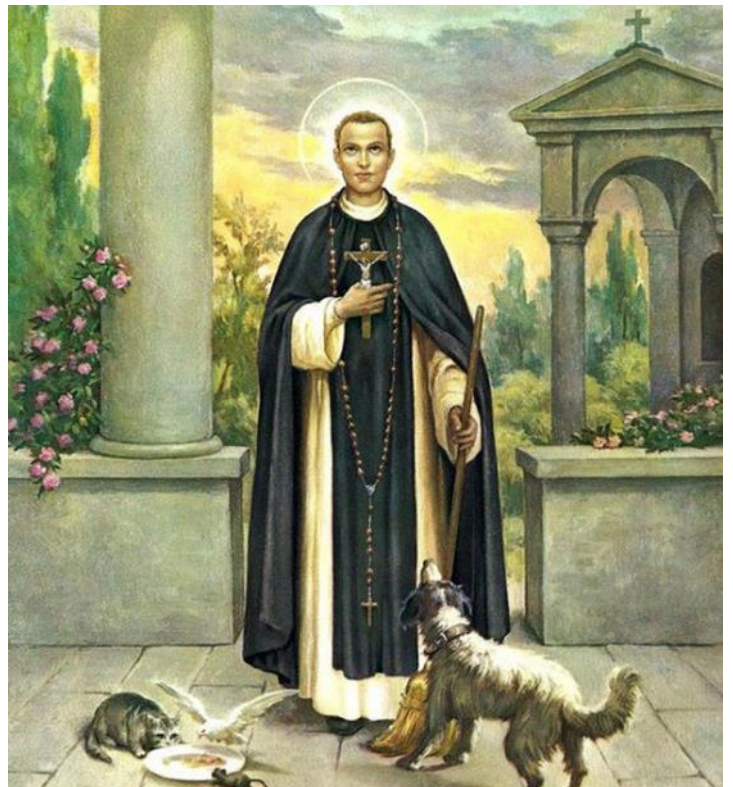

Revivalist/Homilist Biography

Rev. Anthony Bozeman, SSJ, is a priest of the Society of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart, "the Josephites" ([www.josephites.org](http://www.josephites.org)). A native of Philadelphia, PA, Fr. Bozeman received a Catholic education at Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic School, West Philadelphia Catholic High School for Boys, and LaSalle University. Fr. Bozeman served 16 years in the Military and Air National Guard before receiving his call to the priesthood. Fr. Bozeman entered St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia, PA and was ordained in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia on May 20, 2000.

Fr. Bozeman is a Past President of the National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus and a beloved mentor to the National Black Catholic Seminarians Association. He now serves as the full-time Director of Vocations for the Josephites ([www.josephites.org/the-vocation-team](http://www.josephites.org/the-vocation-team)) Fr. Bozeman is devoted to the increase and support of priestly vocations.

He is known for his enthusiasm and reliability, and is highly sought after for preaching, retreats, and revivals.
