Pastor's Corner



If you are reading this on Sunday, I am probably in a vehicle on my way to Disneyland with my sister, brother-in-law, and three nephews – plus a fourth nephew on the way. It has been about twenty years since I last saw Disneyland. From what I hear, the place has changed quite a bit. I have not been a huge fan of the Disney brand during the past twenty years or so, although several of the Pixar movies were pretty good. As a 90s-era-kid, I loved the traditional animation hot-streak of the Little Mermaid, Beauty and the Beast, Aladdin, and the Lion King. Most of the animation flicks that came after that didn't do much for me. As for the park, I hear the "fast pass," which was once meant to help minimize one's time standing in line for rides and was free of charge has been replaced by some complicated-sounding tiered system of speed passes that cost money and function through an app. Thankfully, we will be meeting up with someone there who is a big Disney enthusiast and very savvy about how to navigate the system. Good grief! Oh well, as long as we make it to my favorite ride, Indiana Jones Adventure: Temple of the Forbidden Eye. Traditionally, the few days before Lent were a time when Catholics had parties with whatever remaining goodies they still had in their houses, so, in that spirit, I am going to bake flats of thick, soft shortbread with a mix of the various leftover chocolates we Dominicans still have from the holidays placed on top – stuff like those Ghirardelli chocolate squares, and so forth. I am going to call it "Candy Pizza," which I figure the kids will find fun. See you next Sunday!




