## Pastor's Corner



As we continue our nine-day novena seeking the prayerful intercession of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary, one prayer intention that has been on my mind has pertained to the importance of praying for good spouses for our young people. Typically, over the last fifteen years, I have found my prayers directed more toward the goal of good husbands for our young women. However, lately I have heard from young men who have had difficulty finding good Catholic (or even just Christian) women. The causes of this are varied, although for our men here in the Bay Area, location is a factor. For example, research indicates that in San Francisco for ages 30 to 39, there are more men than women, due to the tech industry being quite male-dominated. Some people, I'm told, are even referring to San Francisco "Man Francisco." Combine that with research showing young women are rapidly becoming less religious than in previous years, and you see that a good Catholic man can have a difficult time finding a suitable spouse in the Bay Area. Whatever we may be praying for in our St. Joseph novena this year, I say we should all include in our prayers a petition for greater conversion for both young men and women, especially in the Bay Area! You never know – perhaps there will be a 'chance meeting' after this Thursday's special 5:30pm mass for the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary at the free pasta dinner afterwards in the parish hall. Although, whether or not anybody meets Mr. or Miss. Right at the dinner Thursday evening, it will certainly be worth attending. We are St. Dominics in Benicia, after all, which means the food will be great! Additionally, the event will feature a return of last year's elaborate St. Joseph Altar. I heard from several people last Lent about how impressed they were by that beautiful display. The décor here at St. Dominic's sure is in capable hands! Also, remember the Solemnity of St. Joseph is a traditional day for collecting food for the needy, and our Saint Vincent de Paul Society would appreciate a canned food donation or a baby item for our Gabriel Project ministry. However, if you do not have that on hand, please do feel free to join us for the free pasta dinner! The St. Joseph's Committee has worked very hard to organize the event, and they always do such a good job. Saint Joseph, husband of Mary, pray for us!
