## Pastor's Corner



The month of May certainly is a time at which bittersweet transitions are upon us. For example, our eighth-graders will graduate in a few weeks. The occasion gives me the opportunity to preach to them some parting words of wisdom as they head off to high school. I always repeat a remark I once heard from the vice principal of my high school orientation, many years ago at Rocklin High. "There are those in high school who are participants in what happens. There are those who just watch what happens. And there are others who, at the end, wonder what happened. In high school, be part of the first group." I love catching up with graduates from previous years and learning about how they are finding ways to participate in what is happening at their high schools. Most importantly, however, I pray they will remember to take the Lord with them into every study session, football game, dance, campus musical production, robotics contest, or whatever else they do during these very special four years. I will also soon celebrate the graduation baccalaureate mass for Saint Patrick/Saint Vincent High School where we Dominicans have ministered since the fall of 2023. At that mass, I always remind the kids of something I often tell them, which is that it is very important that they strive for a sense of their self-worth coming from God's love for them, rather than the vain approval of their peers. We all need to follow that advice. If our confidence and general ability to feel good about ourselves is rooted in the Lord, that means no other person can take that confidence and general self-regard away from us. Well, if you are reading this article on Sunday afternoon, I am likely in Vacaville celebrating my nephew's first Holy Communion. Kids sure seem to grow up fast, don't they? I am so grateful to be assigned here in Benicia, which allows me to see my niece and nephews on a regular basis, and not just on special rites of passage, moments of transition. Let us pray that all of our kids getting their first Eucharist this weekend continues to grow up in households that encourage them to grow in their faith on an ongoing basis. We should all strive for that goal. None of us knows when the Lord will call each of us home for the final transition.

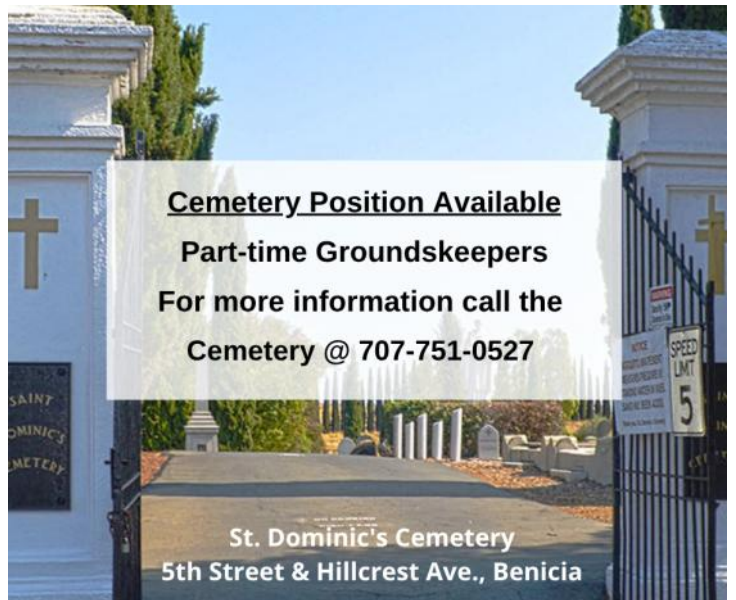

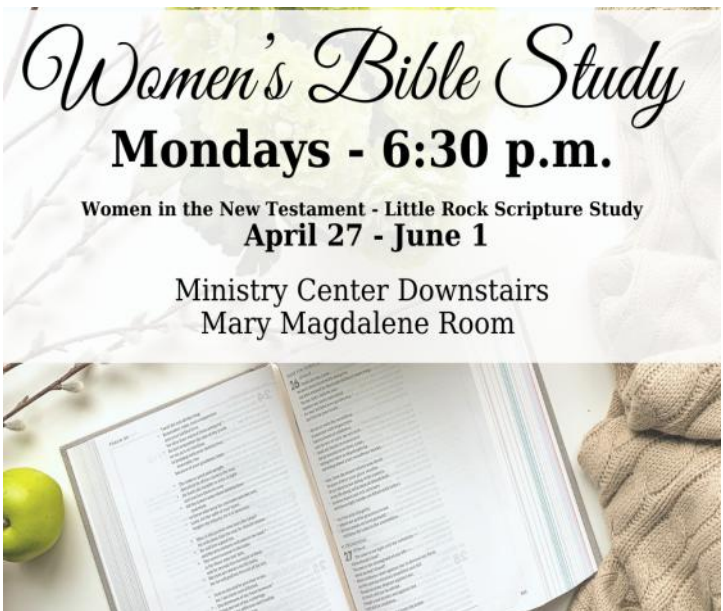
