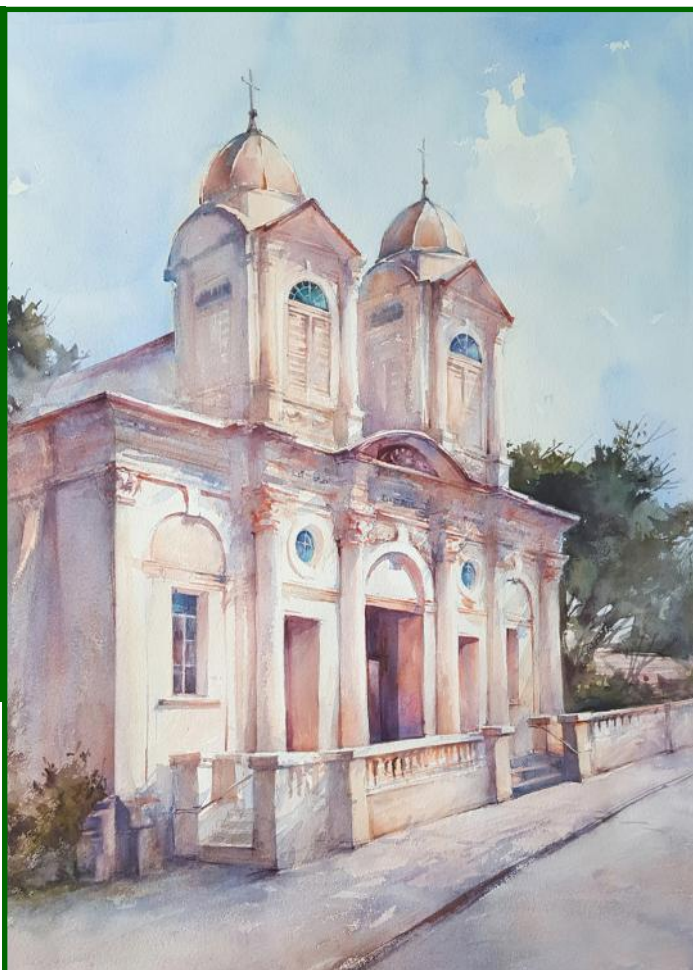

Deacon's Corner

The Holy Catholic Church and you, the beautiful people of St. Dominic Benicia, have a great reason to rejoice, for from among our community one has been called to ordination as a permanent deacon. Next weekend, our longtime parishioner Antonio Gomez, will be ordained a permanent deacon for the Diocese of Sacramento!



In Acts of the Apostles 6:1-6, we hear of the profound moment the early Church called the first seven deacons out of the community of believers for service to the faithful. The fledgling church was growing rapidly and the presbyters (priests) could no longer serve all the needs of the community. Deacons were ordained by the apostles so that the presbyters (which included the apostles) could primarily attend to "prayer and the ministry of the word."

Often the permanent deacon may be most visible to the faithful as a minister of the liturgy and Word while assisting the priest at Mass. But like in the early days of the Church, permanent deacons are ordained for servant leadership. A permanent deacon may be involved in a variety of parish ministries, but should also be involved beyond our campus in the ministry of charity to the poor, sick, incarcerated, or any other place the God's children are in need of care.

Your prayer support is requested. Sunday evening, June 21st, Antonio and his wife Antonia, along with eight classmates and their wives, begin a week-long retreat of final discernment and preparation for ordination. Please join me in praying that this time of focused reflection, prayer, and fellowship will warmly bless them with the peace, affirmation, and courage that only the Holy Spirit can provide.

God willing, Antonio and his classmates will be ordained on Saturday June 27th at Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in downtown Sacramento. Antonio has been formally assigned by Bishop Soto to St. Dominic; his first Mass assisting as deacon will be Sunday, June 28th at 1 PM, with a reception to follow in the parish hall. We thank Antonio for the courage, wisdom, and fortitude it took to answer his vocation calling, for Antonia's prayerful support and encouragement of her husband, and for their family's willingness to share him with the Church.
