At future hospitality events, like the Baking Sundays and Coffee and Donuts, two very important ministries will be tabling to recruit new members — our twenty-four-hour Eucharistic chapel and the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. Both groups make a huge difference in the health of the Benicia region, both physically and spiritually. Our twenty-four-hour Eucharistic chapel is a uniquely valuable asset, spiritually, I am frequently reminded, because it is one of the only chapels of its kind here in the Solano region. Make sure you spread the word about it and encourage others to sign up for time-slots to keep it strong. I often hear from those who pray during the middle of the night that they find that time especially peaceful. As for our Society of Saint Vincent de Paul ministry, they do tremendous work helping our Benicia neighbors with temporal needs during difficult times. On our first day back out in the farmers market this year, a young family who had been helped by them approached our booth to thank us for assistance they got for paying rent after the father of the family had his wallet stolen at a gas station.
